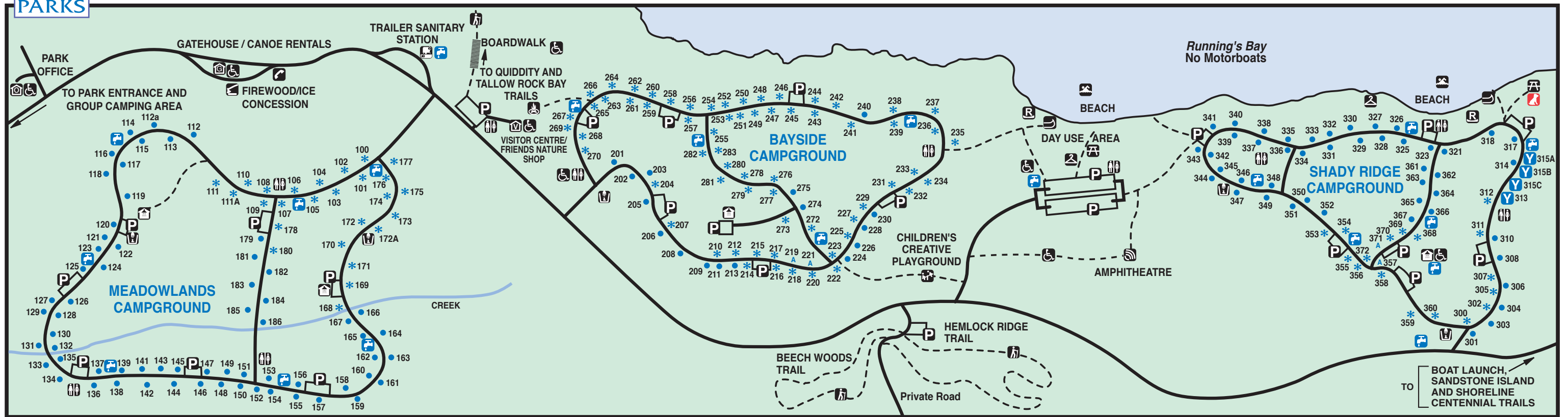

Beech Woods	1.8 km	Yes	Wildlife of the park	Mature forest; diverse habitats	Easy
Hemlock Ridge	1.7 km	Yes	Plant communities of the park	Views of an old beaver pond; rock crevices	Moderate
Quiddity	2.4 km	No	Charleston's diverse habitats	Boardwalk over a wetland; scenic lookout	Easy
Tallow Rock Bay	10.0 km	No	The park's wilder reaches and wilderness	Scenic lookouts; remote areas of the park; floating bridge across Slim Bay	Difficult
Blue Mountain From Huckleberry Hollow From Warburton Road	5.7 km 9.8 km	No	Blue Mountain	Scenic vista (the highest point in Leeds County); mature forest	Moderate
